



2024 Port Malabar Rifle & Pistol Club NRA F-Class Mid-Range Full-Bore National Championship Match Program

Dates: October 10-13 2024

Host: Port Malabar Rifle & Pistol Club. NRA #C1034

Location: Port Malabar Rifle & Pistol Club is in the city of Palm Bay, FL. Exit I-95 at exit 173 westbound on Malabar Road, State Rd. 514. Follow Malabar Rd. 4.8 miles to Hurley Road. Go left on Hurley Rd. The gate to the club is at the road's end.

Rules: All 2024 F-Class & National Championship rules will apply

Eligibility: Open to anyone

Entry: Entries must be received by 10/3/2024 no walk-on entries permitted. Electronic registration and payment only, you will receive an email confirmation. Cost of Registration is \$180.00 for individual competitor, \$80.00 for Juniors, and \$120.00 per 4-man team. Match fees will include awards banquet. Entries are limited to 108 competitors. Registration and Match Program will be available at www.pmrpcrifle.com

Rifles: F-Class Open Rifle (F-O) Rule 3.1(a)
F-Class Target Rifle (F-TR) Rule 3.1(b)

Firing & Scoring: This match will be fired as a 2 person per firing point match (pair fire). With the possibility of a single 3 person firing point (based on an even or odd number of competitors). There will be NO single shooter per firing point. All scoring will be done on the firing line by the competitors alternating shots and scoring. All shooting will be fired on Electronic Targets. A tablet would be the preferred method to interface with the Electronic Targets. Cell phones are too small to be efficient.



Check In & Sight In: Thursday October 10, 2024 starting at 9:00 am, competitors will be able to pick up their match packet at the Stat Shack. Beginning at 10:30 am, the range will be open for a 1 hour per yard line (300/500/600) for sight-in period. This will be a supervised sight-in with a 20-minute time limit per shooter. Pair Firing during the sight-in period is highly suggested to familiarize yourself with Pair Fire mode using the electronic target system.

Squadding: Day 1 squadding will be done by classification and rifle type. Competitors will be squadded by score on Day 2 & Day 3. Squadding will be posted daily.

Awards: A National Championship award will be given to the winners of each rifle type in both Individual and Team matches. Place and category awards given per NRA awards structure based on the quantity of competitors in each rifle type and categories. Cold Bore "X" Challenge coins will be awarded to each competitor that records an "X" for their first Cold Bore sighting shot daily.

Team Matches: Team Matches will begin approximately 1 hour after individual matches are complete. This will allow Individual scores to be posted and challenged if necessary. Each team will have an assigned target. Rule 8.3(a); Full-Bore Rule 7.11(a); & Rule 11.6.8 will apply to all team matches.

Targets: 300 yards MR63-FC; 500 yards MR65-FC; 600 yards MR-1FC

Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) must be inserted into the chamber of all rifles entering the facility/property of Port Malabar Rifle & Pistol Club. This is a Club rule and will be enforced. ECIs must remain in place until preparation period is given, and reinserted prior to rifles being removed from the firing line.

Course Of Fire: All matches will consist of 2 convertible sighters & 15 shots per record per competitor, for both individual and 4-man team matches. All individual matches will have a 2-minute pre-preparation period to bring equipment to the firing line, with a 3-minute preparation period. 4-Man Team Matches will have a block time of 63 mins. Best efforts will be made to begin firing @ 8:00 am, or shortly after.



10/10/2024 9:00 Check-in begins/pickup Match Packet. Rifles can also be weighed at this time (highly suggested). Squadding for sight-in

10:30 am 300 yd sight-in/2 shooters per firing point

12:00 pm 500 yd sight-in/2 shooters per firing point

1:30 pm 600 yd sight-in/2 shooters per firing point

Match 4: Aggregate Match 1 – Match 3

Match T1: 4-Man Team Match; 2 convertible sighters; 15 shots for record per shooter; block time of 63 mins.

Match 5: Pair fire 500 yards; 2 convertible sighters; 15 shots for record; 45 secs per shot

Match 6: Pair fire 500 yards; 2 convertible sighters; 15 shots for record; 45 secs per shot

Match 7: Pair fire 500 yards; 2 convertible sighters; 15 shots for record; 45 secs per shot

Match 8: Aggregate Match 5 – Match 7

Match T2: 4-Man Team Match 500 yards; 2 convertible sighters; 15 shots for record per shooter; block time of 63 mins.

10/13/2024 Day 3: 7:15am Check-in, Daily Awards, & Safety Briefing

Match 9: Pair fire 600 yards; 2 convertible sighters; 15 shots for record; 45 secs per shot

Match 10: Pair fire 600 yards; 2 convertible sighters; 15 shots for record; 45 secs per shot

Match 11: Pair fire 600 yards; 2 convertible sighters; 15 shots for record; 45 secs per shot

Match 12: Aggregate Match 9 – Match 11

Match T3: 4-Man Team Match 600 yards; 2 convertible sighters; 15 shots for record per shooter; block time of 63 mins.

Match 13: Grand Aggregate Match 4, Match 8, Match 12

Match T4: Grand Aggregate Match T1, T2, T3

The Awards Banquet will take place at the PMRPC Pavilion directly after the challenge period of the final Team Match.

Gate keys will be made available to non-members on check-in day for a deposit of \$20. Each will be returned at the end of the competition.
